
Simon Delgraff, Cornelius Cuvelie^{en},
Cader & Olivier Oyen, Arrested or Seizure
against the Owners of the English Privateer
Called the Prince of Orange from Bermuda


Governour & Counsellors Extraordinary assembled; by Petition
have heard the just demand of His^o Simon Delgraff^{en},
Cader Cornelius Cuvelie & Olivier Oyen, order that the
2/3 parts of the Sloop Call'd r. Prince with her Loading or
Cargo, & her Apparel belonging to Owners of the English
Privateer Called the Prince of Orange of Bermuda shall
Be sold by Publick Sale to recover all such pretensions as
the Petitioners will prove to have against the Owners of the
aforementioned Privateer de Prince of Orange according to the
Arrrest made the 30th of August 1738. with the charge of Cost
of it, tho' the Net Proceeds of r. said Sloop & Loading shall
Be sequestered here till the said or the above mentioned
Petitioners shall have proved their pretensions against the
above mentioned Owners of the Privateer & afterwards
shall be disposed of the money proceeds of the sale of said
Sloop & Loading.

in the Town of Phillipsburg in the Island off
Martine the 17th day of November 1738. in Absence
of W^m. Dr. Salomone
