

COMRADE:

Our Annual Reunion this year will again be of the basket picnic or social gathering variety, rather than the formal affairs heretofore indulged in. Summit Park consists of spacious, pleasant grounds, conveniently located, with every facility for enjoyment. It is easily accessible, being located at Oriskany, midway between Rome and Utica, and reached by rail and trolley from both Utica and Rome. The fare from Utica and return by trolley, including admission to the grounds, is only 25 cents, and tickets can be obtained at the Main street office, opposite the N. Y. Central depot. Parties taking the street cars anywhere in Utica, en route to the park, will have their fare to the main office refunded upon purchasing tickets to the park. Parties from Rome can arrive at or leave Oriskany via. N. Y. Central Railroad, at 6.16, 8.37 and 8.56 a.m., or 1.01, 3.01, 4.37, 6.46 and 8.37 p.m., or can leave Rome by trolley every half hour. From the east trains arrive at 7.24, and 11.10 a.m., or 1.19, 4.49, 5.54 8.09 and 9.15 p.m., thus affording excellent facilities for reaching and leaving the grounds. Refreshments can be obtained at the pavilion in the park by those who do not care to take a luncheon, but it is hoped that all will bring not only a basket, but some one to help them empty it as well, and enjoy a full day's outing. Programme will be arranged on the grounds to suit the convenience of those present.
