made the fifth day of July in the fifty sixth year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord George the Third by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland King Defender of the Faith and in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixteen **Between** The Right Honorable Auguste Jules Armand Marie Count of Polignac of the Province of Languedoc in the

Kingdom of France and Peer of France (the second son of the Right Honorable Armand Jules Francois Duke of Polignac Peer of France by Marie Antoinette Martine Gabrielle de Polastron Duchess of Polignac his wife) of the first part **Barbara Campbell** of Cornmagat Place in the Parish of Paddington in the County of Middlesex Spinster (widow said Barbara Campbell and Jane the wife of the Honorable Charles Edward Marquis de Blandford her elder sister are the two only children of Duncan Campbell of the Island of Jura in the County of Argyle Esquire by Mary his wife and are died and are residuary devisees and legatees under the last will and Testament of Duncan Campbell late of the Island of Saint Vincent in the West Indies their maternal uncle deceased) of the second part **Evan Baillie** late of the City of Bristol but now of Dorset in the Parish and County of Dorchester in Great Britain Esquire (a Trustee and Executor of the last will and Testament of the said Duncan Campbell the a Testator of the said part and **The Honorable James Murray** (commonly called Lord James Murray) of Duffield in the County of Perth in Great Britain the said **Honorable Archibald Macdonald** of Cornmagat Place in the Parish of Paddington in the County of Middlesex **James Macdonald** of East Fife in the County of Surrey Esquire and **Reginald George Macdonald** of Glamorgan in the County of Shropshire aforesaid Esquire) of the fourth part. **Whereas** a Marriage hath been agreed upon and is with the permission of Almighty God intended to be solemnly had and solemnized between the said Auguste Jules Armand Marie Count of Polignac and Barbara Campbell with the privity and approbation of the said Evan Baillie the only Trustee under the said will of the said Duncan Campbell the Testator who is resident in Great Britain testified by this being a party to and reading and delivering these presents **And whereas** the said Barbara Campbell is entitled to a considerable real and personal Estate and Settlements of the same have been executed by her for the benefit of herself and the said Auguste Jules Armand Marie Count of Polignac and their issue. **And whereas** the family of the said Auguste Jules Armand Marie Count of Polignac reside abroad and their and his possessions are in France and other Circumstances no Settlement can be executed by the said Auguste Jules Armand Marie Count of Polignac or his Family for the benefit of the said Barbara Campbell or her issue but it is the intention to execute such a Settlement as soon as circumstances admit. **Now therefore these Presents Witness** that the said Auguste Jules Armand Marie Count of Polignac with the privity and approbation of the said Barbara Campbell both hereby for himself his heirs Executors and Administrators Covenant promise and agree with and to the said Lord James Murray Charles Edward Marquis de Blandford James Macdonald and Reginald George Macdonald their Executors Administrators or assigns that when and so soon as the Circumstances of the case will admit the said Auguste Jules Armand Marie Count of Polignac his heirs Executors or Administrators shall and will well and effectually and to the satisfaction and approbation of two persons appointed one of whom shall be chosen by the said Auguste Jules Armand Marie Count of Polignac his Executors or Administrators and the other of whom shall be chosen by the said Barbara Campbell her Executors or Administrators execute or promise to be executed for the benefit of herself and the said Barbara Campbell and their issue such a Settlement of real or personal property as the Secura Advocate so to be appointed as aforesaid is mentioned shall under the Circumstances of the case judge proper and reasonable **And it is hereby agreed and declared** between and by the Parties to these presents that if there shall be any difference of opinion between the two aforesaid Advocates so to be appointed it shall be lawful for them to appoint another Advocate to decide the point in difference and the matter shall be regulated and settled by his decision. **In Witness** whereof the said Parties to these presents have hereunto set their Hands and Seals the Day and Year first above written.
