

This Indenture made the fourteenth day of December Anno Domini 1722 and in the ninth year of his reign
for her said Lord George by the grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender of the Faith & Bellirenn Anne and
Frances Stapleton Joint Executrix of the last will and Testament of Dame Anne Stapleton
of the one part and William Renton of the Island of S. Christopher Esq. of the other part witnesseth that the said Anne and Frances

Stapleton for and in consideration of the said documents and agreements hereafter in these presents reserved unto and
contained on his part and behalfe of the said William Renton his Executors Administr. and Assignees to be paid due and performed as in the said
and by the said term and time above written and to farms left unto the said William Renton All that plantation formerly belonging to his said Master
in a quarter containing about two hundred and forty acres in the Island of S. Christopher aforesaid together with all waters and
watercourses messuages tenements and lands situate within his aforesaid land belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto
formerly in his possession of Matthew Wills and William Woodley and now of his said William Renton **To Have and to Hold** unto him
said William Renton his Executors Administr. and Assignees from the twentieth day of September which will be in his Ward our Lord One Thousand Seven
hundred and twenty and five at which time a Term of Seven Years granted in these said premises to the said William Renton by Dame Anne Stapleton
widow by Indenture dated the fourth day of February anno domini One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seven years will determine and expire
for and during his further Term of Seven Years from thence next ensuing and fully to be completed and ended Subject to such losses
provisions or abatements herein after contained for the sooner determination of this said Term in such manner as herein is expressed **yielding**
and paying therefore yearly during this said Term of Seven Years hereby letter unto the said **W^m Renton**
his
Lodges and Assignes in the said Island of S. Christopher the yearly sum of Twenty Five Thousand pound of good and
merchantable Muscovado Sugar in sacks on the twentieth day of September in every year And if it shall happen that yearly sum of Twenty
Five Thousand pound of sugar shall be behind or unpaid in part or in all by the space of Forty days next after any of the said days or within the same
ought to be paid as aforesaid being lawfully demanded then and from thenceforth it shall and may be lawfull to sue for the said sum
and Frances Stapleton their
Lodges and Assignes or any of them into all and singular his above named premises with his exec
appurtenances or into any part thereof to recover and the same to repossess and enjoy until the payment of such yearly rent or any part thereof so due and
unpaid any sum herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding At W^m Renton Anne and Frances Stapleton

Document promise to grant to and with the said William Renton his Executors Administr. and Assignees by these presents in
manner and form following (that is to say) That he the said William Renton his Executors Administr. and Assignees shall pay him **free labor** of Ingrossed grained
and prepared at the expiration of the term aforesaid or before sooner determination of this present Term to carry away all such mills grained and stills as
he or they shall elect or bring on the said plantation within the term aforesaid At W^m Renton William Renton for himself his Executors Administr. and
Assignees doth covenant promise and grants and writes to the said Anne and Frances Stapleton their
Heirs and Assignes that
he the said William Renton his Executors Administr. and Assignees shall to will well & freely pay the said yearly sum of Twenty Five Thousand pounds of sugar
above reserved to the said Anne and Frances Stapleton their
Lodges and Assignes contained to him which comes often as the
same or any part thereof shall be due and payable during this said Term at sum dais and times and in such manner and forms as the same is before in these presents
limited and appointed to be paid without fraud or deceit and shall and will bear to pay all taxes rates duties payments and assignments which are and shall be
due and payable and agreed to his Master poor or any other amount whatsoever for or in respect of the said named promises or any part thereof during this
said term and from all and every tax rates duties payments and assignments shall and will discharge or hold and sufficiently save and keep harmless his said
Anne and Frances Stapleton their heirs and assigns
and the said named promises and every of them and at the end of the
said term hereby granted or other sooner determination of this present Term (which shall first happen) shall peaceably and quietly yield up unto the said Anne and
Frances Stapleton their heirs and assigns
the said named promises and every part thereof together with all the Dwellings houses buildings and living lands in
them being in and upon his said premises without any waste to be made thereof and also shall leave standing on the said premises one dwelling house builded and living lands in
good repair and likewise all such other Buildings as shall be then standing on the said premises in good condition and repair (casualties and damages happening by
reason of fire Enemis or Verritantes excepted) At W^m That the said William Renton his Executors Administr. and Assignees shall not at any time burn or damage
the said ground or plantation belonging to the said plantation At W^m Renton Anne and Frances Stapleton doe
document promise and grant to and with the said William Renton his Executors Administr. and Assignees by these presents that the said William Renton his Executors Administr.
Administr. and Assignees for the sum of Twenty Five Thousand pounds of sugar aforesaid to be paid and under and according to the several
and agreements in these presents contained which on his and their parts ought to be performed shall and may peaceably and quietly have hold and enjoy his promises
above named with the appurtenances without any lett but trouble written or interruption of the said Anne and Frances Stapleton

or any other person or persons whatsoever remaining by from or under his name being in these presents contained to the contrary notwithstanding
always however held and it is agreed by and between the said parties to these presents that in case before the expiration of this said term hereby letter to the said Island of S. Christopher
S. Christopher shall happen to be taken into his hands or possession of any Prince State or Potentate which now is or shall be at Enmity or War with the Queen of Great
Britain That then and from thence forth this present Indenture and every thing herein contained shall cease determine and be utterly void and of no effect
anything aforesaid to the contrary notwithstanding that the said William Renton his Executors Administr. and Assignees paying and bearing all such Rent as
shall be due and in arrear to that time At W^m Renton whereof the said parties first above named to these presents Indentures interchangably have
set their hands and sealed this day and year first above written T
