

made the Twenty ninth day of April in the Tenth year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord
George the Second by the Grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender of the
Faith & Duke in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety Between John
Nesbitt and Edward Stewart of Fleetmanbury in the City of London Merchants and
Carpenters and Alexander Campbell late of Berwick Street in the County of Middlesex attorney of the Island of
Orkney in the West Indies but now of Temple Street in the said County of Middlesex Esquire of the one Part and

St. John's
William Lushington and James Lawe both of Portland Place in the Parish of St Mary le Bone attorney in
the said County of Middlesex Esquire of the other Part witnesseth that for and in Consideration of five hundred a Piece of lawful
Money of Great Britain to the said John Nesbitt Edward Stewart and Alexander Lawe in hand paid by the said William Lushington and
James Lawe at or before the Execution and delivery of these Presents (the receipt whereof is acknowledged) Between the said John Nesbitt Edward
Stewart and Alexander Campbell *W^m Lushington and James Lawe* and every of them *W^m Lushington and James Lawe* doth sell and by these Presents doth and
every of them *W^m Lushington and James Lawe* doth sell unto the said William Lushington and James Lawe *All that certain plantation formerly a Coffee plantation*
called or known by the Name of St John situated lying and being in the Parish of St Andrews in the Island of Orkney before called the Quarter of
Orkney containing by estimation Ninety nine Quarters of Land & the same more or less being equal to Three hundred and sixteen Statute Acres & to the
same more or less bounded on the North by the River flowing on the East with the Lands now or late in the possession of Mr Bottius now Campbell on the
South side with the Lands of the widow Mrs Rose now owned and on the West by the Estate now or late in the possession of Mr Rose now in
order and all and every the Inhabited Buildings houses habitations buildings houses & furniture belonging thereto
and all fenced Drills and Kitchens erected built standing and being upon or belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said plantation or any part thereof and also
all coppered Halls Halls Kitchens Kitchens Tubs Coopers Cisterns Boiled Pots Kitchens Ladles Pans Kitchens Kitchens Plantation Tools and all
other implements and utensils of what nature or kind soever to the said plantation and premises or any part thereof belonging or therewith usually used or enjoyed or accepted
or occupied held or enjoyed together with all Timber Trees and other Woods and Underwoods common or pasture feeding Wards pastured or
occupied water Watercourses ditches Privileged Enclosures profits Commodities appendages hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to
the said plantation and premises or any part thereof belonging or in any wise appertaining or therewith usually used or enjoyed or accepted
or reputed deemed taken or known as part thereof or otherwise thereof and also all and every the slaves named in the document hereunder written or said
of them as are now living and all other the slaves worked and employed or being upon or about or belonging to the said plantation and premises or any
part or parts thereof and all the slaves slaves used Build Oxen Cows Calves Cattle and live Stock together with the *and*
present and future offspring issue and increase of the slaves of such slaves and stock respectively and also all the dead stock upon the premises and
also all other slaves and all horses mules bulls Cows and other cattle which shall be upon or belonging to the said plantation
Lands and premises or any part thereof and the future issue and increase of the said additional slaves and stock respectively and the Reversion and
Succession Slaves and slaveholding slaves profits and produce of all and singular the said premises To have and to hold the said plantation
slaves cattle hereditaments and premises aforesaid mentioned and intended to be thereby bargained and sold as aforesaid with their and every of their
slaves horses mules Cows and other cattle which shall be upon or belonging to the said plantation and
executed Administrators and executors
Slaves delivered issued delivered and appurtenances unto the said William Lushington and James Lawe his heirs and executors
from the said day next before the date of these presents for and during and unto the full End and Term of one whole year from thence next
following and fully to be paid and made Yielding and Paying therefor unto the said John Nesbitt Edward Stewart and Alexander Campbell
one and sixpence per pound of our Pepper Corn at the End of the said Term (if the same shall be lawfully demanded) To the Intent and
Purpose that by virtue of these presents and of the Statute for transferring into possession the said William Lushington and James Lawe
may be in the actual possession of the said premises thereby bargained and sold and be thereby enabled to accept and take a Grant and Release of
the Reversion and inheritance of the same promised to the use of them the said William Lushington and James Lawe his heirs and executors
subject to such proviso of redemption as shall be thereof mentioned and reserved in and by the Indenture of Assignment Tripartite already prepared
and intended to bear date the day next after the date of these presents and to be made between the said John Nesbitt and Edward Stewart
of the first part the said Alexander Campbell of the second part and the said William Lushington and James Lawe of the third Part *In Witness*
whereof the said parties to these presents have affixed their hands and sealed the day and year first above written
