This Indenture

made the Twenty ninth Day of April in the Twentieth Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord King George the Third by the Grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender of the Faith &c. in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety Between **John Nesbitt** and **Edward Stewart** of Aldermanbury in the City of London Merchants and

Copartners and **Alexander Campbell** late of Abchurch Lane in the County of Middlesex afterwards of the Island of Grenada in the West Indies but now of Wimpole Street in the said County of Middlesex Esquire of the one part and

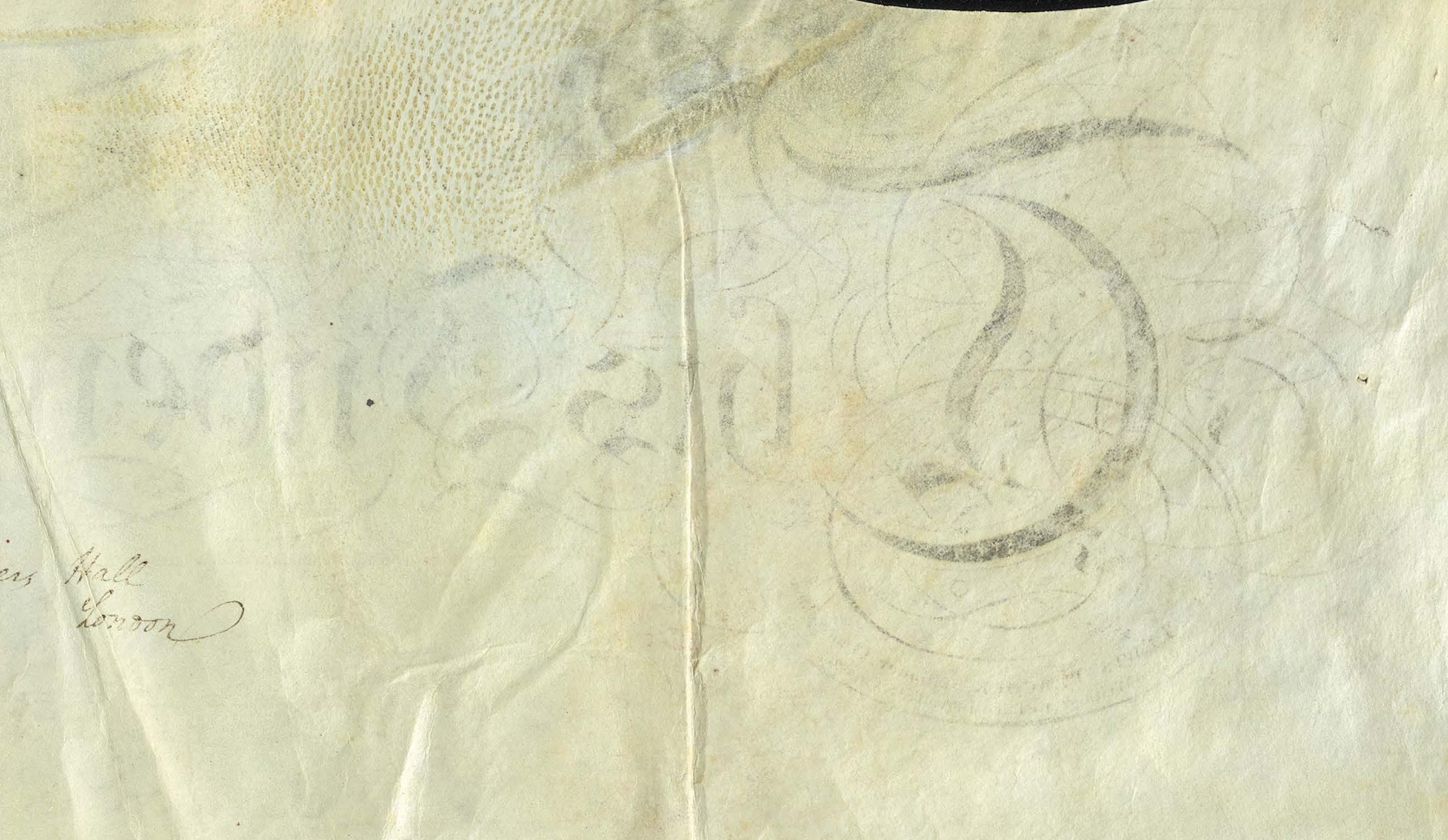
William Lushington and **James Law** both of Portland Place in the Parish of St Mary le Bonc otherwise Marybone in the said County of Middlesex Esquires of the other part **Witnesseth** that for and in consideration of five shillings a piece of lawful money of Great Britain to the said John Nesbitt Edward Stewart and Alexander Campbell in hand paid by the said William Lushington and James Law at or before the Execution and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) they the said John Nesbitt Edward Stewart and Alexander Campbell HAVE and each and every of them WITH Bargain and sold and by these presents DO and each and every of them DOth Bargain and sell unto the said William Lushington and James Law All that Sugar plantation formerly a Coffee plantation called or known by the Name of St John situate lying and being in the Parish of St Andrew in the Island of Grenada heretofore called the Quarter of St Marks containing by Estimation directly nine Acres of Land be the same more or less being equal to Three hundred and sixteen Statute Acres (be the same more or less bounded on the North by the River Antoine on the East with the Land now or late in the possession of Mr Pottins now Campbells on the South side with the Land of the Widow La Roque now Adams and on the West by the Estate now or late in the possession of Monsieur Florent now the Gordons and all and every the Messuages Tenements Edificed Erection Buildings houses Outhouses Storerooms Sugar houses Boiling houses Curing houses still houses Mills and kilns erected built standing and being upon or belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said plantation or any part thereof and also all Coppered Mills still heads Looms Corn Mills Coolers Cisterns Boilers pots Traps Skimmers Ladles Pans Cans and other things and Plantation Tools and all other Appurtenances and Utensils of what nature or kind soever to the said plantation and premises or any part thereof belonging or therewith usually occupied used or enjoyed together with all Timber Trees and other Trees Woods and underwoods Commons Common of Pasture feedings Ways Pastures Passages Waters Watercourses Liberties Privileges Easements Profits Commodities Emoluments Hereditaments and Appurtenances whatsoever to the said plantation and premises or any part thereof belonging or in any wise appertaining or therewith usually occupied or enjoyed or accepted or reputed deemed taken or known as part parcel or Member thereof and also all and every the Negroes and other Slaves named in the Schedule hereunder written or some of them as are now living and all other the Slaves worked and employed or being upon or about or belonging to the said plantation and premises or any part or parcel thereof And all the above named Slaves Males Males Oxen Cows Cattle and live Stock hereon and belonging thereto together with the present and future Offspring Issue and Increase of the said Slaves and Stock respectively and also all the dead Stock upon the premises and also all other Negroes and other Slaves and all above named Males Oxen Cows and other Cattle which shall be upon or belonging to the said plantation and premises or any part thereof and the future Issue and Increase of the said additional Slaves and Stock respectively and the Reversion and Remainder and Residues and all singular the said premises To have and to hold the said plantation and premises and all the above named Slaves Males Oxen Cows and other Cattle and live Stock heretofore mentioned and intended to be thereby Bargained and sold as aforesaid with their and every of their Rights Members Issues Increase and Appurtenances unto the said William Lushington and James Law their Executors Administrators and Assigns from the day next before the day of the date of these presents for and during and unto the full End and Term of one whole year from thence next ensuing and fully to be completed and ended **Yielding and Paying** herefore unto the said John Nesbitt Edward Stewart and Alexander Campbell their heirs or Assigns the Rent of one Pepper Corn at the End of the said Term (if the same shall be lawfully demanded) **To the Intent and Purpose** that by virtue of these presents and of the Statute for transferring used into possession the said William Lushington and James Law may be in the actual Possession of the said premises hereby Bargained and sold and be thereby enabled to accept and take a Grant and Release of the Reversion and Remainder of the same premises to the use of them the said William Lushington and James Law their heirs and Assigns subject to such Proviso of Redemption as shall be hereof mentioned and reserved in and by one Indenture of Assignment Tripartite already prepared and intended to bear date the day next after the day of the date of these presents and to be made between the said John Nesbitt and Edward Stewart of the first part the said Alexander Campbell of the second part and the said William Lushington and James Law of the third part **In Witness** whereof the said Parties to these presents have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and Year first above written.
