1781

My dear friend!

I have received your letter & the money. Every thing was prepared for my getting out to day for the Rendezvous. But the arrival of the french fleet & troops make it necessary to join the Marquis before my leaving this state.

I shall set out to morrow for this purpose. & you my dear friend must join me at Annapolis town where I shall arrive the 7th in the Evening. Oth told me that one of your horses has fallen sick. Nathan brings you one to Supleys it.

Make haste my Dear friend to join me as soon as possible
Col: Walker goes with me to Camp.
