declared to be altered changed or void shall accordingly from thence forth be utterly void and of none effect **And** lastly the said Dame Martha Benyssh doth hereby declare that neither
the said Thomas Hatton nor William Whorwood nor any other who shall in pursuance of the intent or direction of these presents receive any of the profits of the premises shall be chargeable for or liable to
make good any more than he or they shall respectively actually receive and likewise that it shall and may be lawful to or for such person so receiving the said profits from time to time to pay and
deposit the said money into the Chamber of London at such interest or allowance as may be obtained for the same or without any allowance at the discretion of the party so paying the same until the
same shall be due and payable according to the limitations and directions aforesaid **In witness** whereof the said Dame Martha Benyssh hath hereunto set her hand and seal this Eighth day of
day of November In the thirtieth year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord Charles the second by the grace of God of England Scotland France and Ireland King Defender of the Faith etc. in the
