This spirit is now developed with especial reference to old corrupt, dogmas and creeds, that have hung like a blighting curse, and mildew over the pure teachings of Jesus the Messiah. And among those old creeds, dogmas and inpositions, forced upon our race, none have been more pernicious in their influence, than the falsehood and forgery of the miraculous conception, as contained in the first chapter of the book of Matthew; a torgery that has made more Infidels than all the deistical authors that have ever written against Jesus, yes, it has done more injury to the cause of Christ and humanity, than the writings of Thomas Paine, Volney, Rossean, Hume, Bollingbrook, and all other deistical writers combined!

Here is a covenant made with an oath, and when God could swear by none greater he swore by his own holiness, and that oath is registered in the archives of heaven; that his (David's) seed shall endure for ever, and his Throne as the days of heaven, and all christendom agree that the seed here spoken of, is Jesus Christ the Messiah.

The prophet Isaiah in the 11th chapter of his Book exclaims as follows:

"And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a branch shall grow out of his roots : And they shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain: for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the Lord, as the waters cover the sea.

And in that day there shall be a root out of Jesse, which shall stand for an ensign of the people; to it shall the Gentiles seek: and his rest shall be glorious."

From the above quotation we learn that Christ is a descendant of Jesse, and a branch that grew out of his roots, and Jesse was the Father of David. The testimony of Jeremiah in his 23d Chapter is as follows:

"Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will raise unto David a righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth.

In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is his name whereby he shall be called, THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS."

The righteous Branch here spoken of all agree is Christ, and he must be a descendant of David, and proceed from his loins, or he can have no right to David's Throne. We now turn to the New Testament, and first let us hear Christ speak of himself in the Revelation, or vision given to John upon the Isle of Patmos.

The genealogy is traced from Judah, to Joseph the husband of Mary, through three times fourteen generations, and then this writer is represented as saying that Jesus was no relation to any of his progenitors. Suppose I should write the book of the generation, or genealogy of Abraham Lincoln, and I should say John Lincoln begat James Lincoln, and James Lincoln begat Thomas Lincoln, ham Lincoln was on this wise. It was soon found out that he was begotten by some one else, and one that had common sense say, Abraham was a lineal descendant of the Lincoln's? Dare any man say this is not the same child spoken of to Ahaz, in the first part of this paragraph, we answer no, truth answers no, here then we see this child was the son of Isaiah and a virgin prophetess, given as a sign to Ahaz, 700 years befoae the days of Christ.

Thus we have clearly proven that Mary the mother of Jesus did not have a son by the Holy Ghost. To fulfill this prophesy and consequently prove this passage in Matthew to be a base forgery for if this virgin's child spoken of by Isaiah, was born in his day, and he was that child's father, then the child of Mary could not have been born to fulfill a prophesy already fulfilled. We now come to the last unexamined witness in the New Testament.

Saint Luke, in his 3d chapter, he introduces the Genealogy of Jesus as follows:

" Now when all the people were baptized, it came to pass, that Jesus also being baptized, and praying, the heaven was opened.

And the Holy Ghost decended in a bodily shape like a dove upon him, and a voice came from heaven. which said, Thou art my beloved Son; in thee I am well pleased.

And Jesus himself began to be about thirty years of age, being (as was supposed) the son of Joseph, which was the son of Heli."

Please notice, that the words "as was supposed" is here thrown into brackets, put in by transcribers and translators, and don't belong here, leave it out, and it will read thus "Jesus himself began to be about thirty years of age, being the son of Joseph, who was the son of Heli, and so on back to Davidfrom David to Abraham, and from Abraham, all the way back to Seth, which was the son of Adam, which was the son of God.

In this passage God owns Christ as his son spiritually, by the decent of the Holy Ghost, and his flesh is traced through the male line, back to Adam, and Adam is there declared to be the Son of God.— So all the God there is in the berth of Jesus is traced back to Adam, and not to the Holy Ghost; and Luke don't say one word about the Genealogy of Mary, only that she was cousin to Zacheriah's wife Elisabeth, who was of the tribe of Levi.

But Luke is very careful to tell us who Joseph is, and whose seed he is, and where he went to be

"And all went to be taxed, every one into his

And Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judea, unto the city of David, which is called Bethlehem, (because he was of the house and lineage of David,)"

Luke is very particular not to say a word about Mary's lineal descent, but keeps all the time telling us that Joseph is the seed and lineage of David. — In the name of Heaven and truth what difference did it make what lineage or seed Joseph came from if he was no relation to Christ, and he was none unless he was his tather. Was there any need of this war if we had done right? No! Need Christ have shed his blood if they would have received him, and obeyed his laws? No! for he said to them,

"O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, which killest the prophets, and stonest them that are sent unto thee; how often would I have gathered thy children together, as a hen doth gather her brood under her wings, and ye would not!

Behold, your house is left unto you desolate: and verily I say unto you, Ye shall not see me, until the time come when ye shall say, Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord."

From the forgoing we learn that Christ would have gathered, protected and saved the Jews, but they would not receive and obey him and his pure teachings, and they are this day many of them wanderers among the nations for the disobedience and wickedness of their fathers who said "if we let this man alone the Romans will come and take away our place and nation," his blood be upon us and our children.

Howl, ye shepherds, and cry; and wallow yourselves in the ashes, ye principal of the flock; for the days of your slaughter and of your dispersions are accomplished; and ye shall fall like a pleasant ves-

Here we see nations and shepherds, or priests are to fall together. Even politicians foresaw and foretold this war, although priests were perfeetly ignorant and stupid in relation to it.



In one sense two or three pure worshipers who meet in any place out a preacher? under heaven to worship God in spirit and truth; but what constitutes a legally organized New Testament or Apostolic church, consisting of officers, ordinances, gifts and blessings ?-let the glad tidings of good things !" New Testament answer; we quote from Paul's Epistles to Timothy, Ephesians and Corinthians, tively, "no man taketh this honor unto himself,

"These things write I unto thee, hoping to

come unto thee shortly:

But if I tarry long, that thou mayest know how thou oughtest to behave thyself in the house of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and ground of the truth.

There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling;

One Lord, one faith, one baptism,

One God and Father of all, who is above all,

and through all, and in you all.

For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.

That there should be no schism in the body.

And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondly prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments' diversities of tongues.
