

Extract of Mr Clays Letter to Mr Hall
Nov^r. 13. 1816

"I have seen & had much conversation ^{at}
" Mr Wildman - who knows the Mr Tyson you
" Enquire after this person Mr W informs me
" does not act for S^r Pat. Blaine's Estate - but that
" Mr. Pickwood does; & I am sorry to tell
" you that Mr W. expresses himself much
" dissatisfied with Mr Pickwood's Conduct
" & has sent out powers to act in consequence
" this sh^d of course be communicated to
" Gen J. for his government but the infor
" mation sh^d be used wth prudence & caution
" Gen J's box was forwarded by the
" Emerald Capt. Drew & must long since
" been delivered at St. Kitts - Mr Wildman
" appears not indisposed to treat for J's goods
" property in that Island & wishes to know of
" Particulars of it & when situated & price &c
" & if Gen J. will write to him direct or make me
" useful in negotiation I shall be happy
" to be serviceable to him
