of my where abouts I am hear in
the hospital near Washington and
I do not know how long I shall be
hear but I hope not long if they will
send me where I want they should
as soon as I am able. I went before
the board and was examined over two
weeks ago and they took my name for some
thing but I have not found out yet but
I think I will know as soon as I get
able to go up to camp and see the ~~old~~
doctor he can tell me all about it
I think I would like to be at home
to vote but I will send in my
vote soon if I dont come and
bring it myself but I dont know
how that will be if I am condemned
I shall try and get transferred

back to my native state
to do garrison duty there is lots
of the boys getting furloughs now
and are going home to root you
need not ask me how am I going
to root for I can't tell so long before
hand I learn that York state is going
for old man & and I think she will
and there is a good many of the
soldiers that will root for him
unless old Abe does some thing this
fall toward bringing this war to a
close for I think that there is
nothing to hinder him from doing
something for I am sure he has got
enough men if he haint he never
will have

I will tell you about the weather here
I think I never saw so pleasant today
as it is here to day but it has been
rather cool here and we have had
one frost that was Saturday

night

I suppose you have had some
cold weather out in York state I suppose
if I were to come home I would have
to sleep in the air in order to keep
warm I think that this ware
is not going to last to great whitt
for I think we are going to whip or
be whipped and if you want to know
my reason I will tell you why because
they we I say are condemning other
best men that is like myself
and putting all that they can into
invalids revere Theodore I wish
you ~~would~~ would step over
and tell Father that I saw ~~see~~
owell Hale and he said that
he had that the money stole
from shop and I wish I was at
home I would make it all right
he is at home I suppose I will
close and I hope you will
write as soon as you get ~~it~~ it
and tell Abner that I wish he
would write
