

#### How to Reach Waterville

Trains leave Utica on the D. L. & W. Railroad for Waterville at 7:15 and 10:35 a. m., and returning leave Waterville for Utica at 5:30, 5:52 and 8:11 p. m.

There is also an auto bus service from Clinton to Waterville running every other hour each way, commencing at 9 a.m., and comrades who desire to do so can take the trolley cars in Utica at fifteen minutes of and fifteen minutes after every hour from 8:15 a.m., and transfer to the auto bus which leaves Clinton on the arrival of every other car from Utica after 9 a.m., returning in the same way to connect with the trolley line for Utica up to 5:15 p.m. The fare for the round trip from Utica to Clinton and return is 25 cents; and the fare from Clinton to Waterville and return is 40 cents each way. The bus will accommodate 20 or more passengers.
