to write I don't want to do nothing
else but write I am getting quite
a practis now but not enough to
improve very fast we have got a very
good writing master he is a good
plaine writer he dose not put on
the flourish that some dose but he
is a very plain and pretty writer we
have got a new teacher in Arithmetic
the old one is helping make out the
pay roles we shal probably get paid
this month but there will be a lot
sent away soon, I dont expect to
go away at present I am pretty lain
yet my wounds are all heald up and
have been this some time my helth
is pretty good and I am fleshing up I
am as heavy now as I was when I
enlisted I have mullerd some since
I came away I don't think that
you would know me if you should

met me in Boston and you was not
a looking for me; we had a very good
meeting hear Fast day the best that
we have had since we have been hear
they hade a contribution last night
to get mony to send on to the mishanarys
they got twenty five dollars and
if it had been after pay day they
would got a grate deal more -

there has been a lot of Solgers
come in lately there was two from
my Co. Larson Pratt was one, if
I was ever glad to see any one it was
him he did not hardly know one.
Rutilus wrote me that his Cousin
Winslo Packard was dead he belonged
to my Co. Major Leavitt has been
home the news is more encouraging
from Fudricksburg to night; that
fellow has not got his discharge yet
I dont know as I care about mine
at present I have not time to write
any more to night, yours from Seth
