Majesty's Forces under my Command, to  
pay or cause to be paid to Brigadier General  
The Honorable John Knox, Quarter Master  
General to His Majesty's Forces in the Wind-  
ward and Leeward Charibbee Islands, or to  
his Assigns, without deduction, the sum of  
Ten Thousand Pounds Sterling, being to  
enable him to pay the Expences incurred and  
to be incurred in his Department, for which  
he is hereafter to account: And for so doing,  
this with the Acquittance of the said Brigadier  
General Knox, or his Assigns, shall be to you  
a sufficient Warrant and Discharge.
