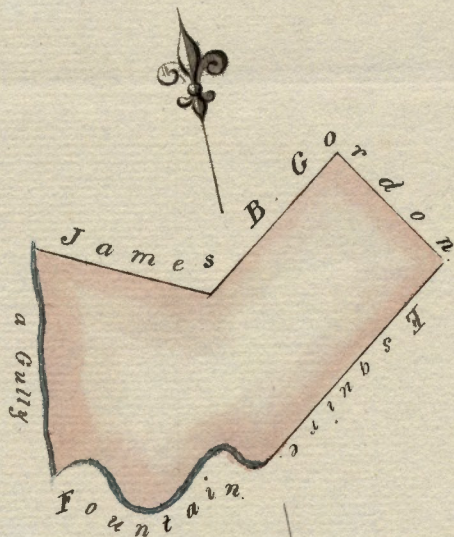

Gordon Esq. on the South by the Fountain Est^o and on the West by a Gully.
